

COLE SAVOY

Native Texan, Cole Savoy's signature sound is laced with sweet and gritty vocals spouting out sunny, life-affirming lyrics inspired by experience and observations of nature, particularly the universal cycle of re-death and rebirth.

His songs are reminiscent of James Taylor and Allen Stone, both in timbre and in spirit, and his diverse influences -ranging from The Beatles, to Incubus to Edward Sharpe and the Magnetic Zeros - have inspired in his writing a unique, soulful, earthy spin on traditional folk and Americana.

Currently, Cole Savoy is in the studio putting finishing touches on his self-titled LP. The album takes the listener on a journey into the heart and soul of Texas Hill Country, exploring the fragile relationships between its precious winding rivers, hills, and the people who live among them.

The album is comprised of 11 original songs and a cover of Kent Finlay's "Hill Country." Many of the songs reflect the artists' lament of the continued development that is affecting the quality of the region's pristine waterways. The album takes you on a soul-journey, with ballads that gently flow like a river, to groovy hip-shakers. His lyrics contemplate what is truly important in a finite life and how we choose to spend our few precious days on earth.

The debut single "Everyday" was featured on the NPR video "[Tiny Desk Contest 2019: Desks in the Wild](#)". The singalong features a rowdy choir of good friends that remind the listener to seize the moments we are given.

Outside of the studio, Cole Savoy marries his love of nature and music by putting on the unique DIY Make a Splash Concert Series. This has been a collaborative effort with Austin, Texas hip hop duo, Thee Unemployed. The vision for this series is to experience music in outdoor spaces where it isn't expected, and to share the magic with others. These concerts have been hosted in creative venues such as a homemade floating stage on Austin's Lady Bird Lake. The last showcase took place on the historic Montopolis Bridge and merged music, art installations, and aerial acrobatics. More Make a Splash shows are lined up for 2023.

Cole Savoy's forthcoming album will be released in September 2023 with tour-dates to follow throughout Texas.
